Question: What does the Holy Qur'an command regarding Dua, i.e. supplication to Almighty Allah?

Answer: We are commanded to supplicate, i.e. make Dua, in the Court of Allah.

It has been stated in the Glorious Qur'an:

And your Creator declared: Make Dua (i.e. pray) to Me, and I will accept it. Undoubtedly, those who are too arrogant to worship Me, shall soon enter Hell, humiliated. [Surah Al-Mu'min (40), Verse 60]

In this verse, Almighty Allah has clearly commanded the Believers to make Dua and has given a clear sign of accepting their Duas and He also informed those who are proud and do not make Dua to Him that they will go into hell.

Almighty Allah says:

وَ إِذَا سَالَكَ عِبَادِى عَنِي فَانِي قَرِيبُ الْجِيبُ دَعُوةَ الدَّاعِ إِذَا دَعَانِ لَا فَاللَّاعِ إِذَا دَعَانِ لَا فَلْيَسُ تَجِينُهُ وَ اللَّاعِ إِذَا دَعَانِ لَا فَلْيَسُ تَجِينُهُ وَ اللَّاعِ الْمُوا بِي لَعَلَّهُمُ يَرُشُدُونَ عَلَى

And O Beloved, When my servants ask you concerning Me, then indeed, I am close. I accept the Dua (supplication) of the supplicant, when he supplicates Me. So they should be obedient to my Commands, and bring faith (i.e. believe) in Me, so that they may be rightly guarded. [Surah Al-Baqarah (2), Verse 186]

Question: What does the Beloved Rasool A say about Dua?

Answer: The Beloved Rasool ﷺ said,



Indeed to ask Dua is Ibaadat

The Beloved Rasool 趣 also said,



Dua is the essence of Ibaadat

Question: Is there any prescribed Dua which should be recited when one is about to depart from his/her home for Hajj or for any other journey?

Answer: There are many Duas mentioned concerning this. However, one such Dua is being presented here which should be recited before departing from your home on a journey.

Bismillahi Wa Aamantu Bil-laahi Wa Tawakaltu alal-laahi Wa La Hawla Wa La Quw-wata il-la Bil-laah. Allahum-ma In-na Na'oodhubika min An Nazil-la Aw Nadil-la Aw Nudal-la Aw Nazlima Aw Nuzlama Aw Najhala Aw Yajhila 'Alayna Ahad

Allah's Name (we) begin with, and with Allah's Help, And I have put my complete trust in Allah, Neither is there any real might, nor any power, except With Allah's Divine Guidance, O Allah! We seek refuge in You, from committing errors by ourselves, or from being caused to err by others, or from going astray by ourselves, or from being led astray by others, or from oppressing or from being oppressed, or from being ignorant, or from others being ignorant over us.

Question: Which Dua can be recited when one is finally departing on one's journey?

Answer: When finally departing, one should recite the following Dua:

Allahuma In-na Na'oodhubika miw Wa'shaa-is Safari Wa Kaabatil Munqalabi Wa Soo-il Manzari Fil Maali wal Ahli wal Waladi O Allah! Verily we seek refuge in You from the difficulties of (this) journey, and from the grief of returning, and from finding our wealth and families and children in a poor condition (on return).

It has been reported that (Allah-Willing) by reciting this, your family, your children, your friends and your belongings will be safe until your return.

After this, it is also advisable to recite from Surah Qul Ya Ayuhal Kaafiroon upto Surah Naas, (i.e. five Surahs) excluding Surah Tabat Yada (i.e. Surah Lahab). Recite Bismillah before each Surah, and end by reciting one Bismillah Shareef. Allah-Willing your entire journey will be smooth.

You may also recite this Dua once for a safe return:

In-nal ladhee Farada 'Alaykal Qur'ana Larad-duka il-la Ma-aad


Indeed, He who has made the Qur'an Fard upon you, will surely bring you back to the place of return

Question: What should one read when boarding a train or plane etc.?

Answer: When boarding a train or plane etc. say the following three times each:

- Bismillah
- Allahu Akhar
- Subhaan'Allah

After doing this, recite the following, for protection from all calamities and hazards,



Subhanal-ladhee Sakh-khara Lana Haadha wa Maa Kun-na Lahu Muqrineen. Wa In-na ila Rab-bina Lamunqaliboon

Glory be to Him, Who has given this in our control, and (yet) we did not possess the strength for this, and undoubtedly, we are surely to return towards our Rabb.

Question: What should one read when disembarking at any port of entry, or when a new city or town is in sight?

Answer: When disembarking at any port of entry, one should recite this Dua as a means of protection against any misfortune:



A'oodhu Bi Kalimaatil-laahit Taam-maati Kul-liha min Shar-ri Ma Khalaq

I seek refuge in Allah's Perfect Word, from the mischief (i.e. evils) of all His creatures.

When a new city or town is in sight, or if you intend to stop over at the particular town or city etc. then recite the following Dua as protection from evil:

Allahum-ma In-na Nas-aluka Khayra Haadhihil Qaryati wa Khayra Ahliha Wa Khayra Maa Feehaa; Wa Na'oodhubika min Shar-ri Haadhihil Qaryati Wa Shar-ri Ahliha Wa Shar-ri Maa Feehaa

O Allah! We ask of You, (for) the goodness of this town (village), and the goodness of the people of this town, and the goodness of whatever is in this town; And we seek refuge in You, from the evil of this town, and from the evil of the people of this town, and from the evil which is in it.

Question: Is there any particular Dua which can be read when journeying by sea?

Answer: When journeying by sea you may recite the following Dua which Allah-Willing is a means of protection from drowning (and sinking etc.):

Bismillahi Majreeha Wa Mursaaha In-na Rab-bi La-Ghafoorur Raheem. Wa Maa Qadrul-laaha Haq-qa Qadrihi Wal Arda Jamee'an

Qabdatuhu Yawmal Qiyaamati Was-samawaati Matwiy-yaatun Bi-yameenihi Subhaanahu wa Ta'aala 'Am-ma Yushrikoon

With Allah's Name is the sailing and anchoring (of this vessel), Verily my Rabb is indeed Most Forgiving Most Merciful. And they (the unbelievers) did not recognise the Sovereignty of Allah as is His Divine Right, whereas on the Day of Qiyaamat, the entire earth, will be worth nothing by Him, and all the skies will be rolled up by His Divine Power; Pure and Supreme is He, from all partners which they attribute to Him.

Question: When on a journey, be it Hajj or any other permissible journey, what should one do when facing an unforeseen situation or some difficulty?

Answer: As per the directive of the Hadith Shareef, it has been mentioned that in such a situation, one should say the following thrice, and Allah Willing the reciter will receive assistance from the unseen:



Ya Ibaad-Allahi A'eenoonee

O Allah's servants! Assist me

Question: What should one do to be safe from hunger and thirst, for protection against bandits, and for protection against shaitaan?

Answer: For protection from hunger and thirst one should recite one hundred and thirty-four times, **Ya Samadu**. For protection from bandits and thieves etc. one should recite **Surah Li-ilaafi Quraysh**. For

protection from shaitaan and other calamities, one should recite **Ayatul Kursi** before sleeping.

Question: What should one do during Hajj or any other journey when one loses something?

Answer: In such a sitatuation, you should read the following Dua sincerely, and Allah-Willing, the lost item will be found:

Ya Jaami-an Naasi Li Yawmil-laa Rayba Feehi. In-nal-laaha Laa Yukhliful Mi-aad. Ijma' Bayni wa Bayna-daal-lati


O You Who will gather the entire mankind, for the day regarding which there is no doubt! Undoubtedly, Allah does not change His Promise. Unite me with what I have lost.

Question: We know that there are three types of Hajj which are performed, i.e. Tamattu, Ifraad and Qiraan. What is the Niyyat for each?

Answer: Yes, there are three types, and the Niyyats for each are as follows:

For Tamattu

In this, the initial Ehraam is for Umrah, and then it is removed after completion and a fresh Ehraam is tied for Hajj, so after performing the initial two Sunnat of Namaaz of Ehraam, one will make Niyyat of Umrah which is as follows:



Allahum-ma In-ni Ureedul 'Umrata Fa Yas-sirha Li, Wa Taqab-balha Min-ni. Nawaytul 'Umrata Wa Ahramtu Biha Mukhlisan-lillaahi Ta'aala

O Allah! I intend to perform Umrah, so make it easy for me, and accept it from me. I have made intention for Umrah and I have worn the Ehraam for it, solely for the pleasure of Almighty Allah.

For Ifraad

In Ifraad one only performs Hajj (and not the Umrah like in Tamattu), and must thus make Niyyat of Hajj only, after performing the two Sunnat of Namaaz of Ehraam, which is as follows:

Allahum-ma In-ni Ureedul Hajja Fa Yas-sirha Li, Wa Taqab-bal-ha Min-ni. Nawaytul Hajja Wa Ahramtu Biha Mukhlisan-lil-laahi Ta'aala

O Allah! I intend to perform Hajj, so make it easy for me, and accept it from me. I have made intention for Hajj and I have worn the Ehraam for it, solely for the pleasure of Almighty Allah.

For Qiraan

In Qiraan, one combines the Ehraam for Umrah and Hajj together, i.e. as one, and must thus make Niyyat of both after performing the two Sunnat of Namaaz of Ehraam, as follows:



Allahum-ma In-ni Ureedul 'Umrata wal Hajja Fa Yas-sirhuma Li, Wa Taqab-bal-huma Min-ni. Nawaytul 'Umrata wal Hajja Wa Ahramtu Bihima Mukhlisan-lil-laahi Ta'aala

O Allah! I intend to perform Umrah and Hajj, so make them easy for me, and accept them from me. I have made intention for Umrah and Hajj and I have worn the Ehraam for both of them, solely for the pleasure of Almighty Allah.

Question: What is Lab-bayk?

Answer: Lab-bayk or Talbiyah is,

لَبَّيْكَ طُاللَّهُمَّ لَبَيْكَ طَلَبَّيْكَ لاَشَيِيْكَ لَكَ لَبَيْكَ طَالَبَيْكَ طَالَبَيْكَ طَالَبَيْكَ فَالْمُلْكَ طُلَاشِي يُكَ لَكَ وَالْمُلْكَ طُلاَشِي يُكَ لَكَ وَالْمُلْكَ طُلاَشِي يُكَ لَكَ


Lab-bayk! Allahum-ma Lab-bayk! Lab-bayka Laa Shareeka Laka, Lab-bayk! In-nal Hamda Wan-Ne'mata Laka Wal Mulk. Laa Shareeka Lak.

I am present here O Allah! I am present here! I am present here (before You), You have no partner. I am present here! Undoubtedly, All Praise

and magnanimity and Sovereignty are for You Alone. To You there is no partner.

Question: What should one read when coming close to the Holy City of Makkah?

Answer: When near the Holy City of Makkah one should reflect on his or her sins and seek forgiveness from Allah, and read the following Dua:



Allahum-maj'al Li Biha Qaraaraw Warzuqni Feeha Rizqan Halaalan

O Allah! Make it a place of Comfort for me, and bless me with sustenance in it, which is Halaal

Question: What should be recited when you are about to enter the Holy Haram Shareef, i.e. the Kaa'ba?

Answer: Recite the following Dua when entering the Holy Haram Shareef with your right foot:

Bismillahi wal Hamdu Lil-laahi was Salaamu 'Ala Rasoolil-laahi. Allahum-ma Sal-li 'Alaa Sayyidina Muhammadiw Wa 'Ala Aali Sayyidina Muhammadiw, Wa Azwaaji Sayyidina Muhammadin. Allahum-magh Fir-Li Zunoobi Waftahli Abwaaba Rahmatika With Allah's Name; and All Praise is due to Allah, and Peace be upon Rasoolullah 懲. O Allah! Send blessings upon our leader Sayyiduna Muhammad 懲 and upon the Noble Family of our Leader Sayyiduna Muhammad 懲, and upon the Blessed wives of our Leader Sayyiduna Muhammad 懲. O Allah! Forgive for me my sins, and open unto me Your Doors of Mercy.

Question: What is the Dua read as the Niyyat, i.e. intention of Tawaaf?

Answer: The following may be read as the Dua of Niyyat:



Allahum-ma In-ni Ureedu Tawaafa Baytikal Muhar-rami Fa Yas-sirhu Li Wa Taqab-bal-hu Min-ni

O Allah! I am intending for Umrah, to perform Tawaaf of your Exalted House, so make it easy upon me, and accept it from me.

Question: What should be recited when facing the hands towards the Hajr e Aswad?

Answer: The following Dua may be recited:

Bismil-laahi Wal Hamdu Lil-laahi Wal laahu Akbar, Was Salaatu was Salaamu Ala Rasoolil-laahi

With Allah's Name and All Praise is due to Allah; Allah is the Greatest; and Peace and Blessings (Salutations) be upon Rasoolullah

Question: What should one recite during Tawaaf?

Answer: One may recite the third Kalima, Durood Shareef and any other Duas.

Question: What should one recite after performing Tawaaf and when approaching the Maqaam e Ibrahim?

Answer: After the Tawaaf, when approaching the Maqaam e Ibrahim recite the verse of the Qur'an:



And take (you) the standing place of Ibrahim, as a place of Namaaz (Prayer).

Question: What should be read when touching the Multazam?

Answer: Read the following Dua:



Ya Waajidu Ya Maajidu La Tuzil An-ni Ne'matan An'amta Biha 'Alay-ya

O The Creator! O The Most Exalted! Do not diminish from me the blessings which You have blessed me with

Question: Is there any Dua prescribed to be recited after completion of the two Rak'aats of Namaaz after the Tawaaf?

Answer: Yes, this Dua has been prescribed in the Hadith Shareef. It has been mentioned about this Dua in the Hadith Shareef, that Almighty Allah says, 'Whosoever makes this Dua, I will forgive his sins, take away his sorrows, remove him from his dependency, grant him greater prosperity in his business compared to all other business people, and the world will be forced to come to him, to such an extent that he will not desire it.'

Allahum-ma In-naka Ta'lamu Sir-ri wa 'Alaaniyati Faq-bal Ma'zirati Wa Ta'lamu Haajati Fa'tini Su-ali wa Ta'lamu Ma Fi Nafsi Faghfirli Zunoobi. Allahum-ma In-ni As-aluka Imaanay-yubaashiru Qalbi wa Yaqeenan Saadiqan Hata A'lama An-nahu La Yuseebuni il-la Ma Katabta Li Wa Arda Minal Ma'eeshat Bima Qasamta Li, Ya Arhamar Raahimeen.

O Allah! Verily, you know full well of my hidden and apparent (condition); Accept my plea; and You know well my need, so fulfil what I ask for; and You know well what is in my heart, so forgive me my sins. O Allah! I ask of You such Imaan which will be embedded in my heart, and true conviction, (so) that I may realise that I will only receive that which You have written for me; and I am satisfied (and completely pleased) with the sustenance which you have granted me; O Most Merciful of those who show Mercy.

Question: What should one recite every time one comes from outside towards the Kaa'ba, i.e. when the sight falls upon the Kaa'ba?

Answer: Even when you enter the first time and see the Kaa'ba and whenever you come thereafter always proclaim:



La ilaaha il'l-Allahu Wal-laahu Akbar

There is none worthy of worship, but Allah;
And Allah is The Greatest

Question: What should one read when drinking the Holy Zam-Zam Shareef?

Answer: The following Dua should be recited:



Allahum-ma In-ni As-aluka ilman Naafi'aw Wa Rizqaw Waasi'aw Wa Amalam Mutaqab-balaw Wa Shifa-am Min Kul-li Daa'

O Allah! I ask of You, for knowledge which is beneficial, and an abundance in sustenance, and and deeds which are acceptable (in Your Court), and Cure from all sicknesses.

Question: What should one recite during Sa'ee of Safa Marwah?

Answer: One should recite the fourth Kalima, Durood Shareef and any other prescribed Duas.

Question: What is the Niyyat when commencing Sa'ee?

Answer: The Niyyat is as follows:



Allahum-ma In-ni Ureedus Sa'ya Baynas Safa wal Marwati Fa Yas-sirhu Li Wa Taqab-bal-hu Min-ni

O Allah! I am intending, i.e. making Niyyat for Sa'ee between Safa and and Marwah, so make it easy for me, and accept from me.

Question: Is there any special Dua to be recited between the two green columns, i.e. nowadays the green lights in Safa Marwa, where men are commanded to run?

Answer: Yes. One may recite this Dua:

Rab-bigh Fir Warham, Wa Tajaawaz 'Am-maa Ta'lam. Wa Ta'alamu Maa La Na'lam. In-naka Antal A'az-zul Akram. Allahum-maj'alhu Haj-jam Mabrooraw Wa Sa'yam Mashkooraw Wa Dhambam Maghfooraa

O Allah! Forgive me, and have mercy upon me, and pardon for me my sins which You know (well) and You know what we know not. Verily You are The Most Exalted and The Most Praiseworthy. O Allah! Make my Hajj an accepted one, and make my efforts adequate, and forgive for me my sins.

Question: If performing Tamattu, the person has already done Umrah, but will put on the Ehraam for Hajj on the 8th of Zul-Hijjah, so what will his Niyyat be now?

Answer: During this time you may make the following Niyyat:



Allahum-ma In-ni Ureedul Hajja Fa Yas-sirhu Li, Wa Taqab-bal-hu Min-ni. Nawaytul Hajja Wa Ahramtu Bihi Mukhlisan-lil-laahi Ta'aala

O Allah! I intend to perform Hajj, so make it easy for me, and accept it from me. I have made intention for Hajj and I have worn the Ehraam for it, solely for the pleasure of Almighty Allah.

Question: What should one recite when Mina is in sight?

Answer: When Mina is in sight, recite the following:



Allahum-ma Haadhihi Mina Famnun Alay-ya Bima Mananta Bihi 'Ala Awliya-ika

O Allah! This is Mina, Bless me with that favour, with which you have favoured your Chosen Servants.

Question: What should be read on the plains of Arafat?

Answer: With all your other Duas there, you should also try to read this Dua.

It has been mentioned in the Hadith Shareef, that Nabi Kareem الملكة has stated that the best of all things which I and all the other Ambia e Kiraam فايم العلوة والتام before me have said on this day is:




La ilaaha Ilal laahu Wahdahu La Shareeka lahu Lahul Mulku Walahul Hamdu Yuhyi Wa Yumeet. Wa Huwa Hay-yul-La Yamootu, Biyadihil Khayr Wa Huwa 'Ala Kul-li Shay'in Qadeer

There is none worthy of worship, but Allah; He is One, Alone without any partner, For Him is the Dominion, And for Him is there All Praise. It is He who gives life and causes death; And He is All Alive, and will never die. All goodness is in His Divine Control, and He has Divine Power over all things.

It is also advisable to recite one hundred times Surah Ikhlaas, i.e. Qul Huw-Allah and Durood in abundance on this day.

Question: What should be proclaimed when striking the Jamraat with the stones?

Answer: When doing so say:



Bismillahi Allahu Akbar. Raghmal-lish shaitaani Ridal-lir-Rahmaani. Allahum-maj'alhu Haj-jam Mabrooraw Wa Sa'yam Mashkooraw Wa Zambam-maghfoora

Allah's Name (we) begin With. Allah is The Greatest. In order to humiliate shaitaan, and to please Allah. O Allah! Make my Hajj an accepted one, and make my efforts adequate, and forgive for me my sins.

You may also just say:



Bismillahi Allahu Akbar

Note: Here we have presented a few Duas which will be beneficial to you. There are however other Duas which can be read at other blessed places during your Hajj. You can find them also in other authentic books.
